Re: Teacher Qualifications

Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

As a parent/guardian of a student at Washington Township High School, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law through the *No Child Left Behind* legislation allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teachers and requires the school district to provide this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Specifically, you have the right to request the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- Whether the New Jersey Department of Education has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the New Jersey Department of Education has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
