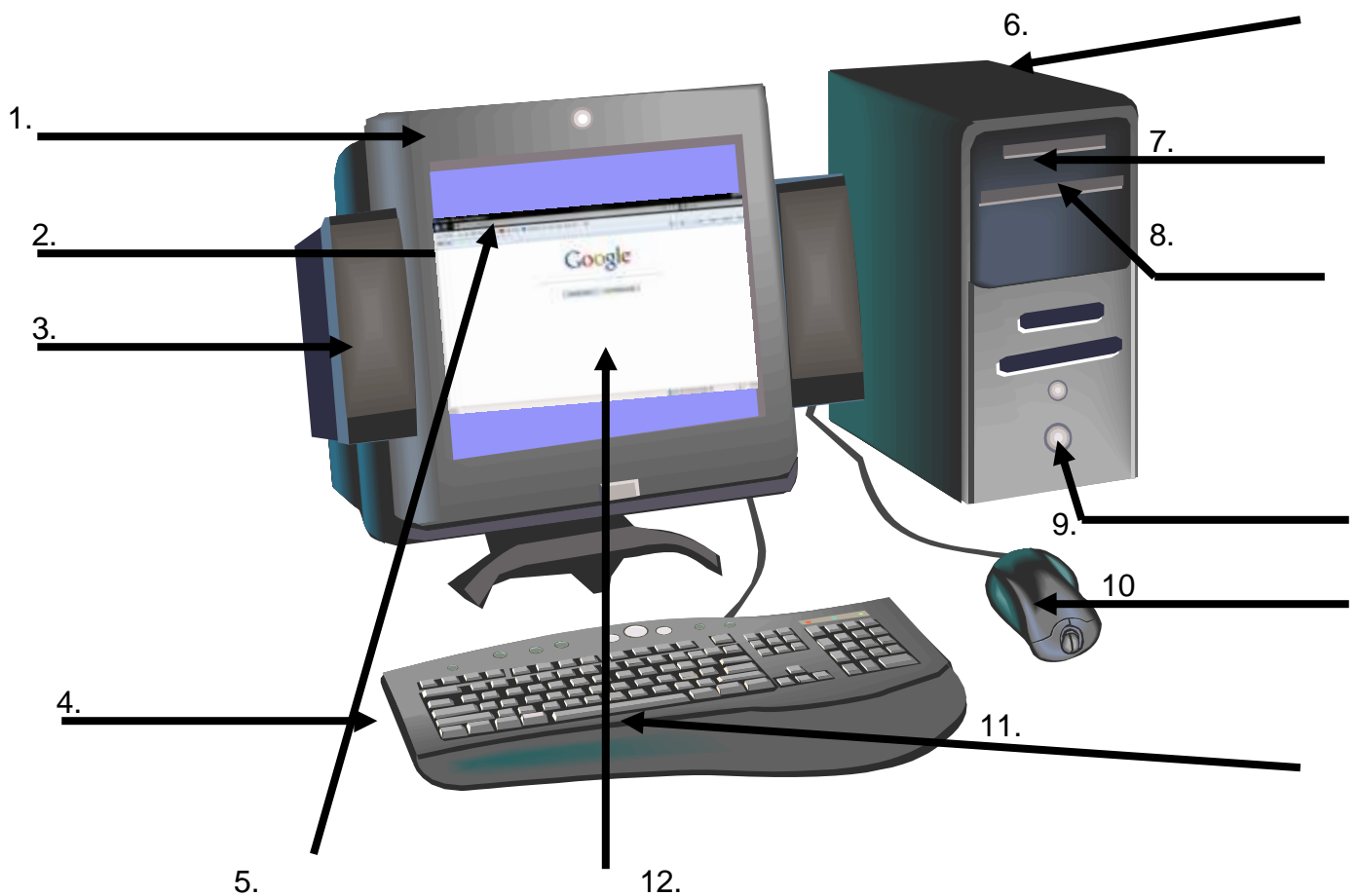


Computer Parts Labeling Worksheet
