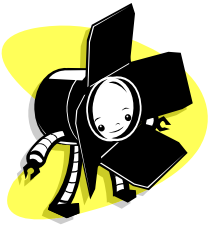

Non Fiction

The Jamestown Project (973.2 Kup) - Describes the history of the Jamestown settlement, its first difficult years, dependence upon local natives, and its eventual influence on later colonial settlements.

Letters to a Young Teacher (371.1 Koz) -A collection of letters in which Jonathan Kozol shares his experiences in the public school system with Francesca, a first grade teacher at a Boston inner-city school whose classroom Jonathan visited while examining the current state of American education.

Flatland a Romance of Many Dimension (530.11 ABB) - Edwin A. Abbott's 1884 tale about the inhabitants of a two-dimensional world and the challenge to their worldview that occurs when one of them, A. Square, meets a sphere and is shown the Land of Three Dimensions.

Grimm's Grimmest (398.2 Gri) - A collection of nineteen of the darkest stories from the Grimm collection of German fairy tales, containing elements that have frequently been removed in other versions.

The Way to Win: Taking the White House in 2008 - Political reporters Mark Halperin and John F. Harris examine the developments in modern presidential campaigns that will shape the 2008 elections and reveal inside details of the last two presidential elections and the factors that influenced their outcomes.
