

STAR Report Terms:

SS – Scaled Score

- raw score based on the difficulty of the questions that were presented to the student and whether or not the student answered them correctly.
- a good score for reporting growth comparing the student's scores to previous scores

PR -Percentile Rank

- the percentage of students who scored lower than a particular student.
- uses numbers form 1-100 (think of students in a line)

GE – Grade-Equivalent

- the grade level of students who on average achieved the same scaled score.

SGP – Student Growth Percentile

- the percentage of academic peers who grew less than a particular student.

IRL – Instructional Reading Level

- the highest grade level at which a student can most effectively be taught (comprehension – 80%, Accuracy – 90-98)

Est. ORL – Estimated Oral Reading Fluency

- estimate of a student's ability to read words quickly and accurately, which in turn leads to efficient comprehension.
- Gr 1-4 only

ZPD – Zone of Proximal Development

- represents the level of difficulty that is neither too hard nor too easy.
- used to level books in AR AS A STARTING POINT for independent reading practice
