Digital Photography

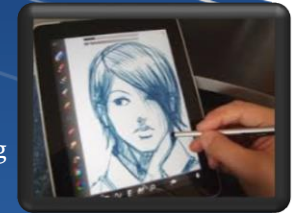
Learning to create and edit digital photos using a DSLR and Photoshop software. Topics covered are history, composition, shooting techniques, and digital workflow.
