Your child is currently enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) course at WTHS and is highly encouraged to take the AP Exam. Please click [here](#) for more information and benefits of AP Exams.

Please follow the following instructions for our high school's **AP Exam Registration and Payment** process:

1. **Total Registration:** All AP students must use this secure site to electronically register and where parent's pay for your child's AP Exam(s).
  - a. **Beginning on Monday, October 7, 2019** [click here for AP Exam registration and electronic payment on Total Registration](#) with the cost of \$94. per exam.
  - b. Follow the directions thoroughly to complete the process.
  - c. **Deadline is Wednesday, November 6, 2019** for the AP Exam(s) to be ordered.
  - d. **Cancellation is Wednesday, November 13, 2019** for a full refund.
  - e. **Cancellation from November 14, 2019 to March 13, 2020** to receive a refund minus a \$40. cancellation fee.
  - f. **Cancellation after March 13, 2020** will not receive a refund.
  
2. **2020 AP Exam Schedule & AP Exam Reminders:** Review the two important attachments. Here are some additional reasons to take an AP Exam:
  - WTPS reimburses a portion of the AP Exam for students who score the following:  
3 = 50%                      4 = 75%                      5 = 100%
  - WTHS Student Handbook explains how to become exempt from an AP course final exam.
  - Standing out during the college admissions process with the student's transcript reflecting AP course(s).
  - Taking AP Exams help students more clearly understanding college expectations.
  - Entering college with AP credits gives students the time to move into upper-level courses in their field of interest. [Click here to find out which colleges accept AP credits.](#)
  - Students who take a corresponding college course, whether by choice or because it is required, will have an advantage over their peers if they take the AP course and exam.
  - Consider your AP scores for the most competitive scholarship awards.

**AP Exam Reminders**

- **LOCATION**
  - Exams will be administered at Washington Township High School, mainly in the IMC.
- **LATENESSES**
  - You will not be given a pass or a reminder to report for exams.
    - If you report late, you will not be able to take the exam, nor will you be reimbursed.
- **ABSENCES**
  - If for any reason you are going to miss the time to attend the scheduled exam, you must call the WTHS Counseling Office (856) 589-8500 Ext. 7419 to inform Mrs. Silvestri, Counseling Secretary, and email your counselor and teacher.
    - It is the school district's discretion to offer Late AP Exams, as they are not regularly granted.
- **CANCELLATIONS**
  - Cancellation is Wednesday, November 13, 2019 for a full refund.
  - Cancellation from November 14, 2019 to March 13, 2020 will receive a refund minus a \$40. cancellation fee.
  - Cancellation after March 13, 2020 will not receive a refund.
  - No cancellations or refunds will be given for Free Reduced Lunch AP Exams.
- **IDENTIFICATION**
  - You must bring your school student ID or driver's license on the day of your exam, since exams could be administered by substitutes and they will not be able to prove your identity.
- **MATERIALS**
  - Bring pencils, black pen, calculator (if applicable), tissues, and a snack/drink (available during break only).
- **ATTENDANCE**
  - Students are marked present for a full day of school if they take one AP Exam per day.
  - Students are permitted to leave the AM Exam when their testing group concludes.
  - Students are permitted to arrive at 11:40 AM for a 12 PM exam without penalty.
  - Students are responsible to communicate with teachers, coaches, advisors, etc. the time they may miss from school, practices, meetings, etc. in advance, and determine how to make up missed time.
