Key Information for Student Taking the SATs Saturday, October 3, 2020 @WTHS

Here are a few reminders for students taking the SATs on Saturday, October 3rd, at WTHS:

- Students must have a Photo ID! (A photo of the ID on a phone will not be accepted)
 - Acceptable photo IDs include:
 - School ID (from 2018-19, 2019-20, & 2020-21 school years)
 - Government Issued Photo IDs such as:
 - Passport
 - Driver's License
 - expired Government Issued Photo IDs will be accepted if they have expired within 1 year of the test date
- Students should bring their testing admission ticket from the Collegeboard website.
- All students are required to wear a face mask and agree to the five following statements:
 - o In the past 14 days, you have not come into close contact (within 6 feet) with someone who has a positive covid-19 test or is presumed to have covid-19.
 - You do not have covid-19 or reason to believe you have covid-19. Symptoms of covid-19 include cough, fever, chills, muscle pain, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.
 - To your knowledge, you are not violating any travel restrictions or quarantining requirements.
 - You agree to wear a mask the entire time you're at this test site and follow instructions from testing staff.
 - We have taken measures to help create a safe testing environment; however, it isn't possible to entirely remove the risk of covid-19 exposure. By entering the testing room, you're accepting that risk.
- Students are allowed to bring snacks and water bottles but must leave the testing room to eat or drink.
- Students should bring their own number 2 pencils and calculator (testing staff will not have any to distribute)!
- Check-In begins at 7:45am- Students should report to the 11/12 cafeterias. Doors will close at 8:00am!
