- Codes for eye color: BLK = black, BLU = blue, BRN = brown, GR = Green, HAZ = hazel
- The instructor will fill in the Name of School, ID & License No. (do not fill in)

3. Student Information Sheet:

- Check appropriate box only if it pertains: If you need to take the written permit test (no charge, and we are licensed by NJMVC to administer this test), 17+ and has Permit, or needs Extra Hours.
 - If you are 17+, you must purchase and validate a permit directly from MVC prior to driving lessons.
