## Dress for success guidelines:

Males: Dress as you would for a job interview.

Appropriate wear includes suit with tie and dress shoes; OR sports coat with tie & dress slacks/shoes; OR (minimum standard) - long or short sleeve shirt with tie, dress pants/dress shoes.

Clothes should generally match and be of a conservative color combination.

Normal uniform grooming standards apply.

You must wear a belt (non-uniform type).

Shirts must be tucked in.

No open-toed shoes, no sneakers!

No excessive jewelry.

Clothes must have a neat, clean, pressed appearance.

ID's/lanyards MUST be worn in formation.

Look professional!

Females: Dress as you would for a job interview.

Business suit/dress with flats, heels, or boots; OR skirt of appropriate length (within 1 inch of the knee.

Hair may be worn down (not necessarily in a bun), but must be presentable/neatly groomed/out of face.

Makeup/nails must be conservative.

Clothes should generally match and be of a conservative color combination.

Other than hair, normal uniform grooming standards apply.

You must wear a belt (non-uniform type).

Blouses should be tucked in when appropriate.

No open-toed shoes, no sneakers!

No excessive jewelry.

Hosiery MUST be worn with dresses/skirts.

Clothes must have a neat, clean, pressed appearance.

ID's/lanyards MUST be worn in formation.

Look professional!
