

Senior Privilege



- Washington Township High School will be granting to 12th grade students the privilege of arriving late to school or leaving early prior to the end of the school day if they are assigned a study hall to start or end the school day.
- Students may arrive late if they are assigned a study hall class(es) 1, 2, 3, 4 and that day's rotation begins with an assigned study hall.

• STUDENTS ARRIVING LATE MUST ENTER THROUGH THE 11/12 MAIN ENTRANCE WITH STUDENT ID.

- Students may leave early if they are assigned a study hall class(es) 6, 7, 8, 9 and that day's rotation ends with an assigned study hall.
 - Students leaving early may promptly exit the building after their last scheduled class.
- This privilege does not excuse students from attending assigned classes. If a student leaves the building and grounds without permission, they will be assigned discipline consistent with the student code of conduct. Any student arriving late to classes will be assigned discipline consistent with the student code of conduct.
- No transportation will be provided for students who take advantage of this senior privilege.
- Please understand that this is NOT required but offered as a senior privilege with parent/guardian approval.
