Small-Group Lessons

- Will take place synchronously while at home.
- Organized by class/voice part
- Cohort R integrated in Cohort A/B/C lesson groups
- Make-up opportunities available
- Grades NOT based on attendance, but demonstration of skills assessed.
- Students will have a lesson approximately once every 3 weeks.

Weekly Learning Activities

- Individual singing assignments (solos, choral parts)
- Music theory (written and aural)
- Sight reading exercises
- Listening responses
- Virtual performance recordings
- Group discussions
- Composition exercises

Grading

- **Supportive Assignments (15%):** Theory, ear training, discussions, and other formative activities.
- Minor Assessments (35%): Small-group lessons, minor vocal assignments, listening responses, quizzes
- **Major Assessments (50%):** Performance recordings, tests, unit skill assessments

Concerts & Performances

- Indoor performances not allowed at this time.
- Our performances will be mostly virtual. We'll record cohorts in class, with remote students recording at home.
 The possibility exists for full ensembles to record together (socially distanced).
- Possible outdoor, live performances when restrictions allow.
