# Take Your Time

**You have 98 minutes in class to take the test, longer if needed! I have NEVER seen a test exceed 60 minutes, so RELAX.**



# Lexile

- **1st 5 questions are the most important!**
- **Your 1st question will be a question on your Lexile level. The 1st 5 weigh the most in terms of Lexile movement. Shifts beyond that point will be somewhat less.**
- **There will be between 20-30 questions depending on how many questions the test needs to determine appropriate level.**



# **Skips**

**You have 3 skips-Use them!**

**Let's say you are not sure of an answer- If there are at least 2 words choices that you are not able to determine the meaning, then you should use a skip.**

**Skips just mean you are getting a different question on that same difficulty level.**

**Skips do not count against you.**

**If you have skips available, and you aren't sure of an answer, and you don't use a skip, it WILL count against you!**
