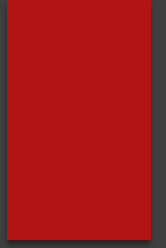

# Complete and accurate information (Research slides)

## **Meets expectations (3)**

Each slide includes the following information for the animal with few errors:

- ▶ Picture
- ▶ Name
- ▶ Size
- ▶ Diet
- ▶ Habitat
- ▶ Predators/threats
- ▶ Fascinating fact

## **Exceed expectations (4)**

Research slides meet expectations, have virtually no errors, and fulfill the following:

- ▶ Demonstrate new learning
  - ▶ Unique theme chosen
  - ▶ Unusual animals highlighted
  - ▶ Varied animal habitats represented
- ▶ Fascinating fact generates questions, curiosity, and/or awe

# Format

## **Meets expectations (3)**

- ▶ Accurate number of slides (8-10 depending on group size)
- ▶ Title slide includes Title, members' names, and class period
- ▶ Reference slide includes 2 books/magazine titles, National Geographic website
- ▶ Font is readable and consistent throughout the presentation

## **Exceeds expectations (4)**

- ▶ Format meets expectations and...
- ▶ slides focus on main ideas.
- ▶ information is represented in bullets not sentences.

## **Exceeds expectations (4)**

Design meets expectations and...

- ▶ Includes uniform slide transitions
- ▶ Includes some animation that adds to the content (be mindful not to overdo)
- ▶ Includes one or a couple videos that adds to the content (be mindful not to overdo)

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- ▶ **Complete and accurate information** (50%) 1 2 3 4
  - ▶ **Format** (30%) 1 2 3 4
  - ▶ **Design** (20%) 1 2 3 4
