## **Seedfolks Quilt Square**

I can analyze details from the story to support the theme of a story. (RL 7.2)

**Directions:** create a guilt square that represents a character and a theme from *Seedfolks*.

## Requirements (expectations):

## 1. A picture that symbolizes your character

Not a drawing of the character but an object that represents the character.

Symbolism= the use of symbols/objects to represent ideas or qualities.

- 2. The character's name
- 3. Three words or phrases that describe your character (traits, values, etc.)
- 4. Connection to the community and the theme of the novel How did your character help to create or embrace the community? How did your character demonstrate acceptance, awareness, and/or tolerance?
- 5. Colorful, creative, and neat.
- 6. **Include a separate paragraph response explaining your quilt square.** Attach the paragraph response to the back of your quilt square. (the paragraph may be typed or NEATLY handwritten).

## **EVERYTHING MUST TIE INTO THE THEME(S) OF THE NOVEL**

- Symbol choice: beyond something mentioned in the novel
- Words/phrases: include quotes (focus on phrases), include specific character traits
- Paragraph: Explanation addresses the symbol and each word phrase with more than one sentence per item.
- Explanation addresses more than one theme.
- Explanation includes direct text references/quotes.
- Explanation extends beyond the character's individual chapter.
