How to Get J-Points

- 1. Once you get to 10 Class Dojo points, you will get a J-Point put into the jar. Class Dojo points are earned by participating, helping others in class, and/or doing what you are supposed to do.
- 2. You can get <u>five J-points</u> by doing a news article summary on a STEM-related topic. In order to get the five points, you will have to summarize the article <u>in your own words</u> in at least <u>seven sentences</u>, and then give an explanation as to why you think the story is important. This should be at least <u>three sentences</u>. Please use spell-check and proper grammar. This should be posted to KidBlog, along with the link to the article. You will then have to briefly present the article in class by telling us what the article is about.
- 3. If you solve one of the brain teasers that we do one day, that will be a J-Point.
- 4. If you do some kind of community service (helping others without being paid), have your mom or dad send me a note or an email about it. This should be something that is not a chore, but something you don't normally do, like helping to rake an elderly neighbor's yard. This will be 3+ J-Points depending on what you do.
- 5. Anything else that I think is deserving.

Choice of prizes:

- 1. Free snack at lunch
- 2. Use of Mr. J's rolling chair for a week.
- 3. Shoot a basketball for a chance to win a choice of the first or second prize AND ten J-Points for future drawings.
- 4. Play one of the apps on the ipads for the last five minutes of class for two classes (volume down).
