tDap & Meningococcal: State Mandated Vaccines

Make appointments w/ child's doctor over the summer

Noncompliance will result in exclusion from school.

Due before the child enters middle school



- Asthma treatment plans with inhalers must be resubmitted with a new date every year
- Medication MUST be delivered by the parent directly to the school nurse
- Medication MUST be accompanied by forms for the administration of the medications
- All medications including Epipens and Inhalers must be current and not expired
- All allergies to food and medications must be on file and on Emergency card



Sports Physicals for fall participation (Field Hockey) are due by August 1st.

Sports Physicals for winter participation (Wrestling or Basketball) are due by November 1st.
