

Unified Classroom Dashboard is Leaving.

What's happening? We are removing the extra, unnecessary layer of PowerSchool that once was required to access our other programs. As we retired Special Programs and PS Learning in favor of Realtime and Schoology, we no longer need this layer. In addition, this extra layer is preventing us from accessing some key features, most notably the App Switcher that will provide one click access to switch between PowerSchool and Schoology. You will keep all your current functionality inside of PowerSchool. Any rubrics you may have built inside of the Unified Classroom will disappear when this layer drops. We encourage you to use rubrics in Schoology instead.

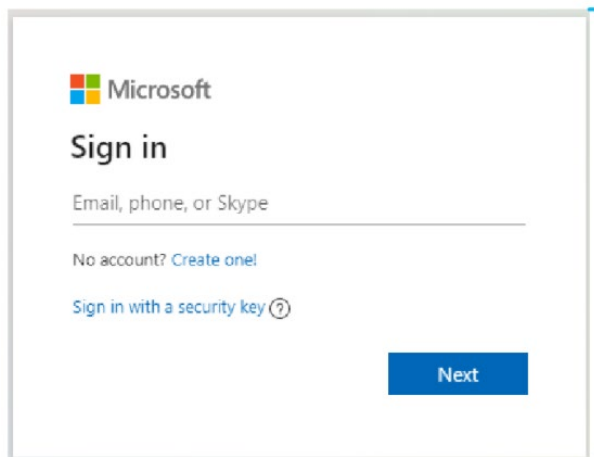

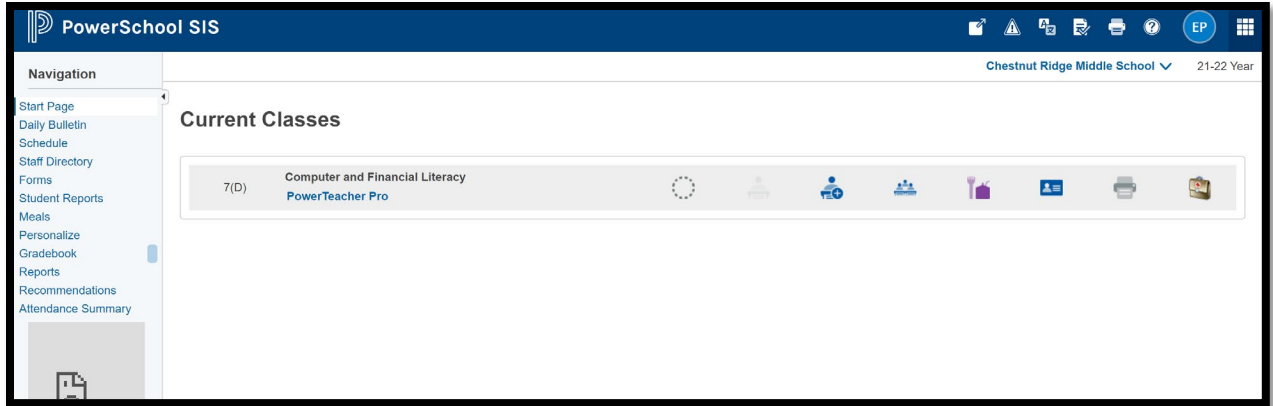
Teachers and Students:

To access the gradebook, you will click on “PowerTeacher Pro” under the class name where you want to start. Your gradebook view will be largely similar as it was during UC
