Dear Parents/Guardians:

Please see below the high school mid-term exam schedule for 2019. These exams will take place from Tuesday, January 29th through Friday, February 1st. Please note that the exams are not scheduled in numerical order but feature a lunch period as the second exam on each of the 4 exam days.

Any student without an exam for the 2nd exam period on a given day, due to it being their lunch or study hall period, may be excused early with a parental note. Notes must be submitted in Cafeteria D for ninth and tenth graders and Cafeteria A for eleventh and twelfth graders. Students who do not have an exam in the early part of the day due to a study hall may arrive to school late for the second exam. If students need to come early or stay at school during a lunch period due to transportation, study halls will be provided in the above-mentioned cafeterias. Please note that school transportation will not be provided for late arrivals or early dismissals.

Please be reminded and discuss with your children that the mid-term exams count as 10% of their final grade and 20% of their first semester average. These exams are a critical piece of their academic success. Please join us in reminding them of the importance and their need to be prepared. We appreciate your support in this.
