Everyday Math Updates

Math Facts ~ Clarification

- ◆ Follow the total minutes on the math fact assessment. Test for the time listed using one color pencil; then have students complete the assessment using a different color. The time listed for testing administration allows us to test fluency. Additionally, the students are able to complete the assessment for practice. This technique also aims to reduce stress by allowing time for students to finish.
- ◆ During the transfer from eBoard to SchoolWires, the first grade fact tests posted were previous versions. The latest versions are now updated and posted. We apologize for the inconvenience.
- ◆ First grade teachers will need to administer the MP2 fact tests for their SGOs by October 1st.
- ◆ The fifth grade multiplication facts are the same pre/post facts throughout the year. Therefore, teachers will only need to assess these 4x's a year because the post test can count as the next pretest.
