Directions: Please complete the <u>mandatory summer assignments</u>. The assignments are on Schoology which can be accessed at <u>wtps.schoology.com</u> and look for *APUSH2 Summer*.

- 1. **Read and take notes** on all of Chapter 16: *America's Gilded Age*.
 - a. Your notes can be typed or hand-written your choice! <u>They will be checked but not collected.</u> (A PDF of both Chapters 16 and 17 are in a folder for you to use on assignment #2 but you only need to read and take notes on Chapter 16).
 - b. For those that would like to use it, there is also a Reading Guide in the same folder for Chapter 16 to help you with taking notes. You can use this guide or your own method of taking notes whichever you feel most comfortable using.
- 2. Complete the chart on major concepts using pages 624-641 from Chapter 16 and pages 650-657 from Chapter 17. They can be found in the **Summer Directions and Chart** folder.
 - a. Please complete the chart using your textbook and/or notes from US 1.
 - b. Please follow the directions on the chart!
 - c. You must cite the page numbers from the textbook or from your notes from AP US History 1 where you found your evidence. <u>If the</u> information is not cited, it will not be graded.
 - d. You should be ONLY looking in your book or your notes from last year for this evidence.
 - e. The chart must be typed.
 - f. The first concept has been done for you as an example.
- 3. There are five short videos in the folder "Men Who Built America" on the Titans of Industry. Please watch the videos and take notes!

The Assignment #2 chart must be typed, is an individual assignment, and will be graded. This means you CANNOT share and copy information with other students or from the internet.
