1. **Read** 17 & 18 (The West: Exploiting an Empire & the Industrial Society) **and take notes** on the chapters. Your notes can be typed or hand-written – your choice! **They will be checked but not collected.**
 2. Complete chart on major concepts from Chapter 17. Please complete the charts using your textbook and/or notes from US 1. **The charts must be typed.** You must also cite the page numbers from the textbook where you find your evidence. **If the information is not cited, it will not be graded.** **You should be looking ONLY in your book for this evidence.** The first concept has been done for you as an example.
 3. There are five short videos on the website on the Titans of Industry from Chapter 18. Please watch the videos and answer the questions that correspond with those videos. Please read all directions!

The summer assignments must be typed and are individual assignments. This means you CANNOT share and copy information with other students or from the internet. All work that is copied or plagiarized from the internet or another student will result in an automatic zero for all assignments in accordance to the school district's academic integrity policy found on page 9 of your handbook. No written work will be accepted. Please come to class with the chart and video question answers printed.
