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## EXAMPLE

Video Title: Simon's Cat - Spider Cat

Who are the main characters in the video? (If there is not a main character, what is the video about?) What is the setting - where does it take place?

Characters - Simon and his cat

Setting - Simon's attic

What was one problem that happened in the video clip? How was it solved, or how could you solve it?

The cat kept turning the light off and on. Simon could have tried to move or distract the cat.

What happened in the video? Use words like "first," "next", and "last" to help retell what happened. Use complete sentences and past tense verbs.

How do you think the main character(s) felt? What clues did you notice to tell you how they felt?

The cat was happy exploring the attic. He looked like he was smiling and having fun.

Simon was irritated at first - his face looked annoyed. Then, he found his old toy, and it made him happy. He did not want to share with the cat.

Then, a spider showed up, and the cat was playing with the light switch cord. He kept turning the light on and off, while more spiders showed up, and Simon got scared and tried to smash the spiders.

Draw a picture of something in the video.
