Clicking "Menu" opens list view of resources. These can also be accessed by clicking any of the icons on the main screen.

Click the large panel to walk through a lesson. (Directly below this panel, students can access previous lessons.)

The "eToolkit" is a student favorite! Tools for practice and play can be found here.

Tutorials offer detailed videos on Everyday Math concepts. They're a great tool for review or absence.
