On Tuesday, May 6, 2025, Mr. O'Brien's kindergarten class at Whitman Elementary School hosted two special visitors, Leslie Canales, an intern from Rowan University, and Food Service Manager, Jennifer Mullin. Ms. Leslie's presentation focused on the question, "Where do our favorite foods come from?". To begin, students discussed the ingredients commonly found in pizza, such as tomatoes and wheat. Students benefited from sensory experiences with new and familiar plants.
