IV. Violation of the following rules will initiate immediate referral to the administration, followed by immediate external suspension.

A. Assault upon a school official/staff member. Student attempts to cause or purposely, knowingly, or recklessly causes bodily injury to a school district employee with a weapon or attempts physically to put a school district employee in fear of serious bodily injury. B. V. Administrative Rights at the Elementary Level

In all infractions not involving a firearm as defined by Policy 8467 and Regulation 8467, the administration reserves the right to impose lesser or greater penalty at any time, based upon the circumstances surrounding the particular infraction, including but not limited to, factors such as developmental age, prior disciplinary infractions, and recommendations of the School Resource Officer and/or local law enforcement.

Nothing within the section shall conflict or be construed to conflict with New Jersey and federal law dealing with the special discipline rules for serious offenses where additional procedures and rules apply. See N.J.S.A. 18A:37-2.1 et seq.; U.S.C. 1400 et seq.
