Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) in New Jersey



■ Ensures programs established and funded for all students, especially students with English as a second language (ESL), students in need of basic skills instruction (students performing slightly below grade level-BSI), and Students participating in the state/federal lunch program.

COMPONENTS OF ESSA'S TITLE I PROGRAMS

■ Allows for specifically trained teachers and provides mandates for after school support with studies and for students who are performing below grade level–targeted interventions

Title I...Allocates funding that includes providing additional professionals to close achievement gaps

TITLE I INTERVENTIONS

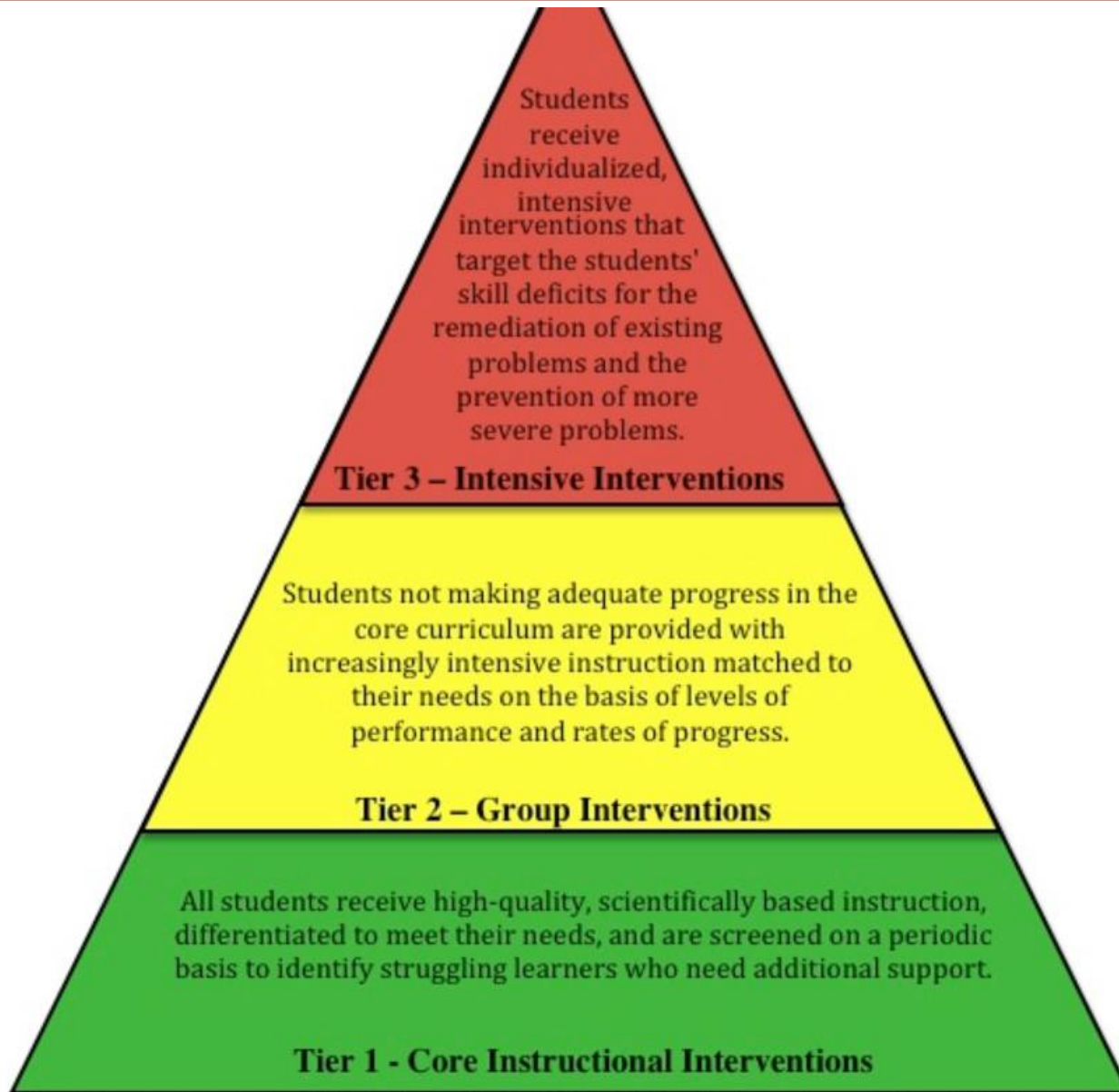
MIDDLE LEVEL BASIC SKILLS INSTRUCTION (BSI)

- **Not all students Title I receive basic skills instruction.**
- **Students are identified through multiple measures, with the STAR assessment providing the most significant constant data.**
- **All students are screened. Screening process involves multiple measures**
- **When students require basic skills instruction services, they receive targeted, standards-based instruction with an extra teacher who targets those identified areas.**
