


WELCOME BACK!

GRADING



At Bunker Hill, we believe in the importance of recovering from mistakes both behaviorally and academically. With summative assessments, all students have an opportunity to master the content.

Retakes come with Recovery Learning. It is not just grade inflation. You have to specifically describe the concept you missed as why. A retest is not automatic. If you demonstrated that you achieved the skill, there may be no need for a retake.



BEFORE SCHOOL & AFTER SCHOOL

- School starts at 7:45am
- If you arrive prior to 7:45am, please report to the cafeteria
- If you are staying after school, you must be with a teacher
- Late bus arrival is at 4:00pm...NO LATE BUSES ON THURSDAYS
 - Know the development you live in!



LAPTOP COMPUTERS

- Insurance does not cover negligence!
- Label your charger
- Never loan anyone your laptop or charger!
- Bring your laptop to school everyday
- Inappropriate technology usage
 - 1st occurrence = warning
 - 2nd occurrence = warning
 - 3rd occurrence = 1 administrative detention
 - 4th occurrence = 2 administrative detentions



ATTENDANCE

- It's important to be in school!
- If you are absent beyond a certain number of days, administration will start issuing Saturday Schools
- Being late to school can and will count towards your attendance record and can count as absences



CODE OF CONDUCT

- Please be sure to take a look at it. You cannot compromise the learning environment for others.
- Cellular/Smart phones and unauthorized electronic devices are not permitted to be used during the school day
- If you do bring a phone to school, it should be left in your locker the entire school day



BATHROOMS

- Open bathrooms
 - Upstairs – 8th Grade Wing
 - Downstairs – By the nurse's office
- Please try not to use the bathrooms during the first 5 and last 5 minutes of the period
- Use of cell phones in the restroom warrants an automatic suspension due to possibly violating someone's right to privacy.



HALLWAYS

If you need to go to the office, IMC, counselor, be sure to get a pass from your teacher.

Any time you are in the hall, you need a pass.

When using the restroom, you need to sign out in the classroom as sign in at the restroom.

You are permitted water for hydration. In your water bottle, there is water only.



LUNCH ROOMS

- Be sure to sit in assigned area
- Any time you are in the hall, you need a pass.
- When using the restroom, you need to sign out in the lunchroom and sign in at the restroom.
- You cannot eat or drink in the hall (water only). No cafeteria food is permitted to leave the cafeteria




BEHAVIOR OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS

- Inappropriate behavior on the school bus, at a school event, or even on Snapchat on Saturday night can bring serious consequences here at school!



DRESS CODE

- Footwear – No flip flops or slides permitted
- Headwear – No hats or hoods should be worn during the school day
- Clothing shall be sufficient to conceal midriffs and undergarments at all times
- Spaghetti strap tops are not permitted at the middle school level. Shirts should not have rude/vulgar language or images
- Backpacks are not permitted
