Dear Washington Township Families:

In light of recent closings at a number of area schools due to air quality, our District proactively commissioned Coastal Environmental Compliance, LLC, out of Hammonton, N.J., to test the air quality of all 11 of our schools. Over the past ten days, five rooms in every building randomly were selected by the company for testing, with additional classrooms and science labs tested at Washington Township High School.

I am pleased to share that all tested areas show our air quality to be of acceptable levels.

Visual inspections prompted the need to professionally clean and remediate multiple classrooms at WTHS, even though air quality samples were acceptable in all but two of these rooms. Subsequent testing after remediation resulted in all rooms being cleared for use.

Coastal Environmental's reports, along with actual lab results, can be reviewed below. We will continue to monitor air quality throughout the District on an ongoing basis to ensure the safety and well-being of our students and staff.
