The Washington Township Board of Education is moving its bi-monthly public meetings from the board room at the Eileen Abbott Central Administration Building to the Investors Bank Performing Arts Center at Washington Township High School (519 Hurffville-Cross Keys Road, Sewell, NJ 08080) until further notice.

Shifting venues to the significantly-larger IBPAC will allow more members of the public to attend in person, while maintaining proper social distancing within the theatre.

“Holding our meetings in the board room did not allow for the public to come and meet with us and participate in the meetings fully,” BOE President Julie Kozempel said. “Moving to the largest venue in town allows for members of the public, or their proxy, to come meet with the board in person, ask their questions, and voice their concerns in a public forum.”

With the shift of venue, board meetings no longer will be held virtually on the WebEx platform. However, meetings still will be made available live via the District’s YouTube channel. Direct links to the live meetings will be advertised on our [website](#) and social media accounts on the day of each meeting.

THE OPEN WORK SESSIONS AND REGULAR SESSIONS will begin at 7 p.m.

THE BOARD may adjourn into Executive Session at any time.
