Gloucester County Institute of Technology is offering a unique, standards-based summer school program for high school students.

The summer program incorporates a NJ Highly Qualified, certified teacher with an online course of study. The program provides access to an in-depth, interactive, online curriculum. It allows the teacher to provide a targeted curriculum that meets the



varied needs of individual students. Students can progress in a self-paced learning atmosphere within the five-week program.
