




## Instructions on how to create your CollegeBoard Account:

STEP 1: Log on to [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org)




STEP 2: Select the “Sign up” button

STEP 4: Complete the General Information Page with First NAME, MIDDLE INITIAL, LAST NAME, GENDER, DATE OF BIRTH, EMAIL ADDRESS (Use your school email address), ENTER THE YEAR YOU WILL GRADUATE, AND YOUR HOME ZIP CODE.
