


Ways to Apply to College & Trade Schools

Application Types





Pros:



- Early acceptance letter
- Schools know your commitment

Cons:

- Acceptance is binding
- Don't let your grades slip due to an early acceptance



Early Action (EA)

Pros:

- Early acceptance letter
- You won't need to withdraw other applications

Cons:

Still prepare your other RD applications



Regular Decision/ Regular Admission

Pros:

- Later deadlines
- No commitment to any school

Cons:

- Competition to bigger applicant pool
- You'll wait for your decision longer



Rolling Decision/ Rolling Deadline

Pros:

- No deadline
- No commitment to any school

Cons:

 No deadlines can make it easy to forget!



Naviance & Common Application





- Add colleges to list
- Fill in application
- FERPA Agreement

Why should you consider waiving your right of access?

Waiving your right lets colleges know that you will never try to read your recommendations. This reassures colleges that recommenders have provided support that is candid and truthful.

You are free to respond as you wish. If you choose NOT to waive your rights, some recommenders may decline your request and some colleges may disregard letters submitted on your behalf.

Enter Common App email address & date of birth and select Match Accounts.





Under "Colleges I'm Applying to", you can get a quick summary of your due dates.






















Under the Application column, you'll update your application status.






When you have decided where you'll attend, you'll need to update your attending college and complete an additional Naviance survey *before* Graduation.

Speak to your counselor on how to provide the most updated information about yourself.



Letters of Recommendation



Formally request letters from teachers, advisors, coaches, etc.

- Ask those who know you best.
- Provide due dates.
- Teachers may ask students to provide information about themselves for talking points in their letters be sure to check with them about which method they prefer.


