This Lesson Plan should be used as a guide. Activities have corresponding approximate times for students to complete. Students may or may not be able to complete each activity during the extended homeroom. **All students are required to complete the Post-Fair Survey (Activity 10).**

LESSONS & ACTIVITIES

1. Naviance: Career Key (*Assessment will take 10-15 minutes*)

- Show video before completing lesson: [Naviance Self-Discovery Assessments](#)
- Students will use the Self-Discovery feature in Naviance to reveal career clusters that align with their interests, values, skills, and abilities.
- Assessment will map students results with Holland's 6 personality traits.

2. Naviance: Explore Careers & add to "Favorite Careers and Clusters" (*Activity will take 15-30 minutes*)

- Show tutorial before completing lesson: [Career Search](#)
- Students will use the Explore Careers feature in Naviance to identify and narrow down careers that interest them.

3. Naviance: Road Trip Nation (*Activity will take 20-25 minutes*)

- Show video before completing lesson: [Naviance Roadtrip Nation Career Exploration](#)
- Place students into groups of 3-4 people.
- Students will be asked to watch 10-15 videos related to the field of interest for each student.

4. Allow students to take 10-minute break.

5. Naviance: SuperMatch College Search (*Activity will take 10-15 minutes*)

- Students will use the SuperMatch College Search tool to identify colleges, trade schools, or military.

Naviance: Resume Writing <i>(Activity will take 25-30 minutes)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Show video before completing lesson: Naviance Building a Resume - Students will use the Resume Writing tool in Naviance to assist in preparing and writing comprehensive resumes. - Students can write and edit as they progress through high school and download copies to be printed or sent electronically.
<p>8. Allow students to take 10-minute break.</p>
<p>9. Group Interview Preparation <i>(Activity will take 20-25 minutes)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Present this handout for students on classroom screen: Classroom Activity and Lesson (Interview).docx - Break students into pairs. - Using educational & soft skills knowledge and common college/employment interview questions, have students practice interviews with one partner acting as the college representative/employer and the other partner as the interviewee. - Have students switch roles.
