Dear Families of Students in Cohorts A, B, and D:

WTPS utilizes STAR Reading and Math screening and benchmarking tools to support teachers in planning instruction. You should have received a district letter further explaining STAR and how this assessment is utilized. However, slight revisions have been made to the testing dates and times.

In order to maximize in-person instructional time in the hybrid schedule, we plan to assign the STAR Reading and Math assessments to your child either <u>remotely or in-person</u> as follows.

- Cohort A students will take STAR Reading in-person and <u>STAR Math remotely</u>.
- Cohort B students will take STAR Math in-person and STAR Reading remotely.
- Cohort D students will take both the STAR Reading and Math assessments remotely.

TESTING SCHEDULE:

All students taking the STAR <u>remotely</u> will be assigned to take the assessment <u>on the same date and</u> <u>time as their in-person classmates</u>. The average time to take each test is approximately 30 minutes. In order to monitor testing of all students, your child will receive a Webex link from his or her ELA or Math teacher to join the class when the period begins. In-person and remote students will be prompted to begin the test at the same time.

- The STAR assessment will be administered on October 5 or 6 for Reading and October 9 or 10 for Math, following the schedules below. Your child will take the STAR Reading during his/her ELA class on Monday or Tuesday and the STAR Math during his/her math period on Thursday or Friday. Outlined below are the times remote students should login to the class Webex, depending on when your child's ELA or Math class occurs.
- STAR Reading Assessment (Cohort A in-person; Cohort B and D remote)

REMOTE TESTING Guidelines:

It is important that your child take STAR assessments <u>independently</u>, so teachers have the results they need to plan instruction that best meets the needs of your child. STAR assessments will not impact a **student's grade**. To assist your child when testing remotely, please:

- Encourage your child to stay calm and do his/her best. STAR is a computer adaptive test, so students will see challenging items they will not be able to answer. It is okay when this happens.
- Ensure your child is well-rested, had a good breakfast, and does not feel rushed.
- Provide a quiet environment that is free from distractions.
- Provide pencil and scratch paper for math work (NOT calculators).
- Stay nearby to ensure student remains focused without hovering.

Student Login Info:

- On the day of the assigned test, students will login to STAR as they have in the past. Go to wtps.org Students Student Resources (Student Intranet) STAR Assessments Continue to new platform now I'm a Student.
- Or, students can directly access the login page here: https://global-zone20.renaissance-go.com/welcomeportal/16425
- Please reach out to your child's teacher if he/she does not remember the username/password.
- Remind students to click the correct test assigned that day (i.e., STAR Math on the day math is assigned or STAR Reading on the day reading is assigned).
- Students will NOT be prompted to enter a monitor password.

For remote testers, if your child is unable to take the assessment with his/her class during the

scheduled time, he or she will be able to take this test between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM on the day the test is assigned.
