- 1. Inform the attendance office that your child will be with you at work.
- 2. Upon your child's return to school please provide a letter from your employer and on official letterhead that your child attended work with you.
- 3. At that time your child will receive an excused absence.

4. *It is important to note that while this is an excused absence it is a day that counts toward the district attendance policy. Therefore it counts as an absence and can affect perfect attendance records or can have disciplinary consequences if this absence puts a student beyond 15 days absent.
