Dear Families of 6th graders attending orientation tomorrow and Wednesday. This letter is to provide some last-minute details for your child to have a successful experience in their first visit to Bunker Hill this year. We are excited for your child to start the journey with us. We as a staff are very proud of our school, the families we serve and the children we work with. We feel this is a special place and hope you find this to be the same over the next few years. This year marks our 25th anniversary as a school so it's an especially exciting year.

For any questions about transportation, please contact transportation at 856-589-9190. Please be aware that if you didn't sign up for a bus or registered late, we did not allocate a bus for you. It is based off of how families registered. If you are driving your child, please drop them off at the front of the building between 9:20 and 9:30. We will then escort them to the cafeteria to begin the activities. Please be at the school at 12:30 to pick them up. We ask that you park in a space in the lot and we will have the children meet you in the parking lot. We ask that no parent pull into the bus lane.

Over the two days, we will be focusing on "getting to know you activities", reading a schedule and practicing lockers, and understanding the instructional technology. Keep in mind we don't have schedules finalized yet. They will be finalized prior to the end of August. Students will be working on combination locks as well navigating the halls. We will also be serving snacks and water in a socially distanced manner during a 30-minute block at a time. Students are permitted to bring their own water bottle if needed.

All students must bring their charged school issued laptop with them.
