Attention 6th Grade Families...IMMUNIZATIONS NEED TO BE ON FILE FOR YOUR CHILD

Some families have not provided a record of required immunizations to the school. This is very important. Please see this link: <u>Immunizations Requirements</u>

It outlines the state rules for immunizations that EVERY 6th grader must have. For all 6th graders who have not provided a record of their immunizations, a letter was given to your child and a letter will be mailed home. If you received this letter and your child does not obtain his or her immunizations, the school and district is required by state mandate to EXLUDE THE STUDENT FROM SCHOOL UNTIL THE IMMUNIZATIONS ARE OBTAINED. We are giving until November 6 to fulfill this requirement. After November 6, any 6th grade who does not have up to date immunizations will not be permitted at school. We apologize if this is an inconvenience, but it is a mandate in New Jersey.

Strategic Plan Climate Survey Permission Form
