Dear Family:

In Unit 4, I will review the **exception** to the **vowel-consonant-e syllable**. This exception, **-ive**, can also be a suffix (as in $\underline{a} \cdot c \cdot (i \cdot v \cdot e)$). It is pronounced with a short i sound. I will point out that the e in **-ive** is added because words in English never end with the letter v.

Students will also learn a new spelling rule for adding suffixes to **vowel-consonant-e syllables**. When adding a consonant suffix to a word that ends in a silent **e**, students will simply add the suffix:

A ${f v-e}$ syllable with a consonant suffix is marked like this:

However, if the suffix begins with a vowel, students will drop the ${\bf e}$ before adding the suffix:

A $\emph{v-e}$ syllable with a vowel suffix is marked like this:
