MUNICIPAL SHUTTLE BUS

The Washington Township Municipal Shuttle Bus operates Monday through Friday for residents of Washington Township. The bus follows a scheduled route on Monday through Friday. Passengers must call the Parks and Recreation Office each morning between 8:30AM-8:45AM to confirm pick-up. Call the Parks and Recreation Office for any further information at 856-589-3227.

MEDICAL APPOINTMENT INFORMATION

Washington Township offers bus service to Township Senior Citizens (age 55 and over) having doctor appointments or needing any medical testing done within Gloucester and select Camden Counties, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30AM and 2:30PM. Residents should call the Parks & Recreation Office at 856-589-3227 as soon as their appointment with the doctor is made as availability is limited.

WASHINGTON LAKE PARK

Washington Lake Park is open 6:00AM to 10:00PM during daylight-savings time. After dark, access is permitted in lighted areas only. Winter hours of operation are 6:00AM-8:00PM. The park will be closed during inclement weather when trails are icy and/or snow covered. Park rules are available at the park service office, which is located in front of the concession stand. If you visit Washington Lake Park and are disabled and need assistance, please call the park. Our staff is ready to make your visit with us pleasurable. For information, please call 856-589-6427. This 410+ acre park can be accessed from either Hurffville-Cross Keys Road or Greentree Road. The park includes an adventure play area geared for ages 5-12, a tot lot geared for ages 2-4, an adventure play area geared for ages 5-12, soccer fields, a baseball field, combination soccer/softball fields, 2 basketball courts, 5 tennis courts, 1 street hockey court, 1 pickleball court, 4 sand volleyball courts, 2 futsal courts, a dodge ball court, bike/walking paths, a 16 station fitness trail, open play areas, 3 picnic pavilions available to rent, restrooms, an open-air amphitheater where many events take place such as concerts, movies and other charitable events. The all-new Cedar Lake Park is now open! This area features scenic walking paths, brand new fishing docks, and two unleashed fenced dog areas for our furry friends! You can also walk your leashed dog in this section of the park only. You can access the park from off of Chapel Heights Road or by taking the path in Washington Lake Park behind Parking lot G.
