Dear Parents / Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that <u>Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass</u> lessons will be offered as part of the regular school curriculum for students entering the 4th or 5th grade for the *2024-2025* school year. In this packet you will find all the rental information you need! Please thoroughly read through all of the information in this packet.

All lessons will be given in school, without charge. Students will miss class on one day of the week – once for a group lesson during the day; and then second time for full orchestra rehearsal at the end of the day. The group lesson rotates time slots on a weekly basis, so your child will not miss the same class from week to week. The orchestra rehearsal happens during a free period so no instruction is missed.

You will be responsible for providing an instrument and a lesson book for your child. The goal by the end of the year is for students to be able to read music, understand basic music theory, and perform with the school orchestra.

This can be an intimidating excursion for both student and parent. This is a packet with all the necessary information regarding the rental process for an instrument.

In order to assure an early start in September, we are asking that parents and students make their decision at this time as to whether or not they wish to participate in this program.

Instrumental Music Programs

THE IMPORTANCE OF A QUALITY MUSICAL INSTRUMENT

To the Parents/Guardians of Beginning Orchestra Students:

As a performing member of the band or orchestra, an important tool in the improvement of your child's playing ability is his/her instrument. The instrument is the vehicle that brings the total musical experience to life. Though they may all look alike, rest assured that a good musical instrument can go a long way toward making the musical experience a positive one. As teachers, we have experienced how certain versions of instruments can inhibit the progress of a student. We find that students who play a better-quality instrument often find playing to be easier, their sound to be better and band or orchestra class to be more enjoyable.

There are many quality instruments from which to choose. If you are interested in making an investment in your child's music education, please consider the rental or purchase of a quality musical instrument. String students have a variety of makes and models to choose from. **If you find other brands you like, please get in touch with someone you trust for advice**. In addition, string students must use an appropriately sized instrument. Your school's string director will measure your child to ensure that they use an appropriately sized instrument. As your child grows, larger sizes will be necessary. Rental programs typically allow you to trade up to larger sizes as your child grows, without additional cost.

If you choose to purchase an instrument from an individual or non-traditional music store, be sure to inquire about warranty, support and availability of loaner instruments in the event a repair is needed. For various reasons, including the availability of parts, some traditional music stores may not repair instruments purchased in non-traditional music stores. Purchasing an auction-type instrument, whether new or used, can also be problematic. Some instruments may be in good shape however most instruments, especially older ones, require a visual and playing inspection to accurately ascertain their quality and playability. A used instrument frequently requires repair and set-up to make it playable. This can add significantly to the overall cost.

For more information, please contact your child's string specialist, consult your child's private music instructor or visit one of the local music stores that provide quality instruments. Thanks again for supporting your child's participation in band and orchestra.

- 15. Fill out the rest of the required information and review and place order. You will receive an email confirmation of your order.


